Find out when the **Plum Island Light** is open for tours, and explore the inside!

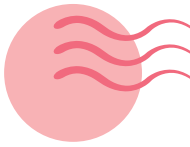


Find the tower at the **Hellcat Wildlife Observation Area**. Use your senses to think of some words that would be great for a poem about nature.
